## Samuel Willenberg 1923- 2016



**Samuel Willenberg**  
1923-2016

**1939**  
On 25 September, he took part in a skirmish with the Red Army near Cheim and **was badly wounded.**

**1942**  
On 20 October, he was brought to the **death camp in Treblinka.**

**2 August 1943**  
**The revolt in Treblinka**  
Out of 840 camp prisoners, 400 managed to break out; roughly 70 of them survived the war, including **Samuel Willenberg.**

**1944**  
When the Warsaw Uprising broke out, he became a Home Army soldier and joined the "Ruczaj" Battalion.

**1950**  
He emigrated to Israel with Krystyna Lubelczyk, saved from the Holocaust by a Polish family.

**1993**  
He started working on his sculptures of Treblinka victims.
